Osteopathy: Everything you need to know

There are 2 kinds of osteopaths: A Doctor of Osteopathy (DO) and Osteopathic Manual Practitioners (DOMP). A DO or Doctor of Osteopathy is trained in the US and are physicians. Osteopathic Manual Practitioners are trained in the rest of the world, European style, and receive their DOMP or Diploma of Osteopathic Manual Practice.
