Congress gave six states (five states initially - California, Minnesota, Nebraska, Oregon, and Wisconsin; and then Alaska upon statehood) extensive criminal and civil jurisdiction over tribal lands within the affected ...

Public Law 83-280 (commonly referred to as "Public Law 280" or "PL-280"), was originally enacted in 1953 and did two things to alter the usual allocation of criminal jurisdiction in Indian country. First, on the reservations to which it applied, it took away the federal government's authority to prosecute Indian country crimes based on 18 USC 1152 (the Indian Country General Crimes Act) and 18 USC 1153 (the Major Crimes Act).
