Acceptability is a subjective measure based on hedonics (pleasure), which in turn is influenced by the sensory properties of the food, previous exposure to it and subsequent expectations, contextual factors, an individual's culture, physiological status (i.e., hunger, thirst, and presence/absence of illness), and many other variables.
