Articles 5 and 24 of the GDPR require that controllers be able to demonstrate compliance; Article 5 specifically defines 'accountability' as being responsible for, and being able to demonstrate compliance with the requirements of the Regulation. As a reminder, in short, the Regulation requires that personal data be:

Accountability is one of the data protection principles - it makes you responsible for complying with the GDPR and says that you must be able to demonstrate your compliance. You need to put in place appropriate technical and organisational measures to meet the requirements of accountability.

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) integrates accountability as a principle which requires that organisations put in place appropriate technical and organisational measures and be able to demonstrate what they did and its effectiveness when requested.

## **Accountability obligation | Data Protection Commissioner**

As the party with the direct relationship with the individual, they need to adopt accountability measures that deliver the necessary security and trust around processing. Another GDPR obligation for data controllers is ensuring their data processors are in compliance. Article 28(1) states that:

## **GDPR Compliance, Data Transparency and Accountability**

GDPR: third-party data processors' responsibilities. Under the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation), your organisation's compliance requirements depend on whether you are a data controller or data processor. A data controller is the person or organisation that determines how and why personal data is processed.

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is the toughest privacy and security law in the world. Though it was drafted and passed by the European Union (EU), it imposes obligations onto

organizations anywhere, so long as they target or collect data related to people in the EU. The regulation was put into effect on May 25, 2018.

Your obligations under the GDPR will vary depending on whether you are a controller, joint controller or processor. The ICO has the power to take action against controllers and processors under the GDPR. Individuals can bring claims for compensation and damages against both controllers and processors.

Transparency requirements under the GDPR. Under the accountability principle laid out in Article 5.2, a data controller “must be able to demonstrate that personal data are processed in a transparent manner in relation to the data subject.” These transparency obligations begin at the data collection stage and apply “throughout the life ...

Accountability is also one of the obligations in the European Union General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”).<sup>4</sup> Accountability is a fundamental principle of the Personal Data Protection Act (“PDPA5”), which requires organisations to ensure and demonstrate compliance with the PDPA.

## **GUIDE TO ACCOUNTABILITY - PDPC**

Under the GDPR, a controller must notify the Data Protection Commission of a personal data breach without delay where that breach is a likely to result in a risk to the rights and freedoms of the data subject. Notification should be made within 72 hours of the controller becoming aware of the breach.

## **Obligations of data controllers and processors under the GDPR**

On September 9, 2020, the UK Information Commissioner's Office ("ICO") published an Accountability Framework, designed to assist organizations in complying with their accountability obligations under the EU General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"). The GDPR's accountability principle requires that organizations both comply with their legal requirements under the GDPR, and also demonstrate their compliance.

C. Accountability under the GDPR As mentioned, the GDPR expressly incorporates accountability as a requirement. Although this requirement is stated explicitly with respect to controllers, the GDPR also includes increased statutory and contractual processor obligations that imply accountability obligations for processors. 1.

## **The Case for Accountability: How it Enables Effective Data ...**

The GDPR introduces additional statutory compliance obligations directly on processors by expanding on their current obligations, and provides that a processor will be directly liable to data subjects where it does not comply with its obligations or acts outside instructions of the controller, and may be subject to direct enforcement by supervisory authorities, fines for non-compliance, and compensation claims by data subjects for any damage caused by breaching the GDPR.
