ESCAPE + Character sets the key sequence to use for switching from session to command mode. For example, to set Ctrl+P as your escape character, type set escape, press Ctrl+P, and then press Enter. LOGFILE FileName sets the file to be used for logging Telnet activity. The log file must be on your local computer.

Telnet commands are TCP/IP commands. You must specify the procedure name on all commands; otherwise, the command is processed by the default TCP/IP stack instead of by the Telnet procedure. For example, assuming that the Telnet procedure name is TN3270E, the profile display command is as follows: D TCP,IP,TN3270E,PROFILE
