If auditory deficits aren't identified and managed early, they can lead to speech and language delays and academic problems. Some of the more common symptoms seen in 3-5 year old children include sound sensitivities and difficulties discriminating between speech sounds, which is often reflected in their speech.

Because language processing disorders can vary in severity and can include either receptive or expressive impairments or both, the symptoms of language processing disorders can also vary greatly. The disorders will look different in everyone. However, language processing disorders do have some general patterns and symptoms that you can watch for.

Characteristics of Language Processing Disorder in ...

If your child has auditory processing disorder, they may find it difficult to listen in a noisy place. They are easily distracted by noise. This is because they may not be able to identify the primary sound from background noise - a necessary auditory skill known as auditory figure-ground. APD patients also have a short auditory attention.
