Vaginal bleeding during pregnancy is any discharge of blood from the vagina. It can happen anytime from conception (when the egg is fertilized) to the end of pregnancy. Light bleeding, or spotting, during pregnancy is common, especially during the first trimester.

Bleeding in the first trimester happens to about 15-25% of pregnant women. Light bleeding or spotting can occur 1-2 weeks after fertilization when the fertilized egg implants in the lining of the uterus.
