A plant with ONE cotyledon is called a Monocot - these include corn or any other grasses, pineapple, onion family.

The leaves & veins are parallel and monocot flower parts (petals, sepals) that cluster in 3s or multiples of 3. Plants that have 2 cotyledons are called dicots - they include the majority of vegetable crops.
