The Stony Brook Reading and Language Project has developed a method of reading to preschoolers that we call dialogic reading. When most adults share a book with a preschooler, they read and the child listens. In dialogic reading, the adult helps the child become the teller of the story.

The key technique is called "dialogic reading," and it's basically just interacting with and engaging your kids as you're reading to them. The goal: Turn the story into a two-way dialogue, as opposed to a passive listening activity.

The best story times are very interactive: You are talking about and reading the story, your child is talking, and there is conversation taking place between the two of you — what educators call "dialogic" reading. Most parents of preschoolers realize the value of reading aloud every day to your young child. Story time is a great way to connect with your child, to share exciting stories and pictures, and to increase your child's understanding of the world.

The analyses also demonstrate how talk, reading and writing are interwoven. As they worked together to determine the importance of key sections of the texts they were reading, the dialogic readers (Maine, 2015) in the experimental group used their language to interthink and put their talk to work (Littleton & Mercer, 2013). In the Test of Textual Integration (TTI), arguably the written task was a demonstration of the children's reading strategies.

Dialogic reading deepens children's engagement with a story and text through enjoyable interactions with an attentive adult. It helps emergent readers develop strong literacy, comprehension and language skills. Children (especially reluctant readers) generally enjoy this type of reading more than traditional reading.
