DIFFERENTIAL ABILITY SCALES - Pearson Assessments

In this case, the ability score with the smaller SEM is from Item Set 1-16 (Ability Score = 95, SEM = 5). The smaller SEM indicates that we have greater confidence in the accuracy and reliability of that ability score. It is that score that should be used as the basis for reporting the child's normative T score.

Psychologists depend on the DAS-II to provide insight into the manner in which a child processes information, giving solutions to fix learning problems. For testing, the participants from the ages of 2-6 or 11-1 years must respond to 63 multiple-choice items.
