Epstein-Barr virus (EBV) pharyngitis may be clinically indistinguishable from streptococcal pharyngitis. Throat culture for group A streptococcus is positive. However, 3% to 30% of patients with IM may have positive throat culture for group A streptococcus, and differentiating carrier state from true streptococcal infection in patients with IM can be challenging.
