In Mombasa, the Mazrui dynasty was appointed to govern the island in 1741. However, the operation was not successful as expected: after the murder of the sultan of Oman, Saif ib Sultan, the first Mazrui governor of Mombasa, Muhammad ibn Uthman al-Mazrui, refused to subordinate to the new ruler, Said al-Busaidi.

The Mazrui families fled Mombasa and some settled in Gasi (Kwale County) and others moved north of Mombasa and established themselves in Takaungu (Kilifi County) So Takaungu was established by the fleeing Mazrui Dynasty who refused to recognise the authority of the new Sultan of Oman who was from the El Busaidy Dynasty.
