Clean Body and Parts in Solvent Once you've removed all the major moving parts, clean the carburetor in a solvent bath with something green, such as Simple Green. Using a brush, clean off the dirt on the outside, getting as much off as you can, especially near openings. Clean the inside with a light stream of solvent or a very light burst of air.

Spray carburetor cleaner on the metal parts inside the carburetor. Makes sure the choke plate and throttle move freely without sticking. Spray them with cleaner.

### How to Clean & Repair Carburetors on Briggs & Stratton ...

Soak the carburetor in a bucket filled with just enough carburetor cleaner to cover the carburetor. You can also use an aerosol carburetor cleaner to spray the carburetor parts. If you use the aerosol cleaner, place the small tubing that comes with it into the nozzle to direct the spray into all the small passages on the carburetor.

Dry soda blast followed by ultrasonic cleaning, in that order. The soda cleans them very well, and since it dissolves in water, the ultrasonic cleaner takes care of any soda that can't be removed with compressed air. You don't need a ultrasonic cleaner, but that means that you will be manually rinsing the carbs in a bucket of hot water.

### The BEST method for cleaning carburetors - How-To ...

Use carb cleaner a few times at several minute intervals to make sure you get everything out. Now you can spray carb cleaner all over the carburetor. Spray up inside again and even spray some on the outside. Wait several minutes before reinstalling all the parts again so the cleaner has time to clean and drip off all the dirt.

### How To Clean A Motorcycle Carburetor Without Removing It ...

Look into the larger hole near where the main fuel supply line connects to the carburetor. If you see varnish buildup or trash in the screen, use a solvent (carburetor/choke cleaner) to dissolve it. For heavy buildup, you may need to fill a small, clean solvent proof container with solvent and soak the complete assembly for a short time to dissolve it.

Next, carefully disassemble the carburetor parts, taking notes and photos to aid in reassembly. Then, liberally spray the individual parts with Walbro's new carburetor and fuel system cleaner.
