### Washington Landlord Tenant Laws [2020]: Renter's Rights & FAQs

Landlord-Tenant If you rent your home you are covered by the Residential Landlord-Tenant Act (RCW 59.18). In a 1985 decision, the Washington Supreme Court ruled that the Consumer Protection Act does not cover violations of the Residential Landlord-Tenant Act.

### Chapter 59.18 RCW: RESIDENTIAL LANDLORD-TENANT ACT

Laws About Landlord Responsibilities. Notice for Entry: A landlord must give a tenant a 2 day advanced notice about an intent to enter a rental, except in the case of an emergency. The notice must include the specific time and date of planned entry, and give the tenant a contact number to dispute the entry.

### Washington State Landlord-Tenant Laws Resource Guide

No, a landlord cannot enter without the tenant's consent in Washington state. Landlords have the right to enter the renter's home for necessary repairs or inspections that were agreed upon. The only exception to this rule is in case of an emergency or if a tenant has abandoned the rental unit.

### Washington Landlord Tenant Laws - Landlord Tenant Act

A lease, which must be in writing, is a legally binding contract, specifying the period of time for which the tenant must remain in the apartment. If the tenant decides to leave the property he/she must continue to pay until the time specified in the lease has expired.

### Tenant Rights | Washington State

State law regulates several rent-related issues, including late and bounced-check fees, the amount of notice (at least 30 days in Washington) landlords must give tenants to raise the rent and how much time (three days in Washington) a tenant has to pay rent or move before a landlord can file for eviction.

The notice shall inform the tenant of the tenant's responsibility to maintain the smoke detection device in proper operating condition and of penalties for failure to comply with the provisions of RCW 43.44.110 (3). The notice must be signed by the landlord or the landlord's authorized agent and tenant with copies provided to both parties.

Many laws apply to the relationship between tenants and landlords. We explain the most common state laws regarding your rights and responsibilities as a tenant.
