The Transformational Learning Theory originally developed by Jack Mezirow is described as being "constructivist, an orientation which holds that the way learners interpret and reinterpret their sense experience is, central to making meaning and hence learning" (Mezirow, 1991). The theory has two basic kinds of learning: instrumental and communicative learning.

Transformative learning is the expansion of consciousness through the transformation of basic worldview and specific capacities of the self; transformative learning is facilitated through consciously directed processes such as appreciatively accessing and receiving the symbolic contents of the unconscious and critically analyzing underlying premises.

As opposed to the elements critical for the process of transformative learning, the outcomes indicative of transformation may include Cranton's (1992) framework of three types of change: change in assumptions, change in perspective, and change in behavior. Boyd (1989) claims an outcome of transformative learning includes a change in self.

According to the Transformative Learning Theory, there are 3 dimensions involved in "perspective transformation": 1. Psychological. Learners change their perspective or understanding of themselves. Based on the Transformative Learning Theory, for real learning to take place individuals must be able to think autonomously.

Transformative learning refers to those learning experiences that cause a shift in an individual's perspective. It is based on the idea that learning is "the process of making a new or revised interpretation of the meaning of an experience" (Mezirow, 1990). This happens when adult learners change their assumptions or expectations.
