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### Phase I Cultural Resource Investigations

Phase I - Intensive Archaeological Investigation This phase of investigation is appropriate in initial project planning and development. It is designed to assess the general nature of the cultural resources present and the probable impact of the proposed project on archaeological sites. In other words, it represents the "identification phase" in which all sites are located during survey.

### Phases of Investigations - Cultural Resource

Phase I investigations are the most common type of Cultural Resource Management (CRM) project, and generally consist of four tasks: (1) a literature and records search; (2) fieldwork; (3) laboratory analysis; and (4) report preparation. The literature and records search identifies known historical and archaeological properties within or in the vicinity of the project area, and establishes a cultural context for understanding any possible cultural resources that might be affected by the project.

### Phase I Cultural Resource Surveys - Weaver & Associates

Powers Archaeology, LLC was contracted by the CHA to perform Phase I Cultural Resource Investigations for the Proposed Little Apple Granny Smith Project. The proposed project will involve the development of an approximate 37 acre / 15 hectare parcel that is located at 3799 Lake Shore Drive East in the Town of Dunkirk, Chautauqua County, New York.

Phase I Archaeological and Cultural Resource Surveys are the most common form of Section 106 compliance currently employed throughout the United States. There are two types of Phase I surveys currently offered by P2P Environmental: a Phase I cultural resources survey and a Phase I archaeological resources survey.

The primary goal: of Phase I Cultural Resource Investigations are to identify archaeologically sensitive areas, cultural/sacred areas and standing structures that are at least 50 years old, that may be affected by a proposed project and to locate all prehistoric and historic cultural/archaeological resources that may exist within the proposed project area.

### Standards for Cultural Resource Investigations

Cultural Resource Investigations are conducted in stages commonly referred to as Phase I, II and III. A discussion of each phase follows. Phase I Investigation. Phase I investigation consists of a combination of background research and fieldwork designed to identify resources and define site boundaries within a given project area or Area of Potential Effect (APE).
