Readings hit 1°C at 11 pm (7/16) and 0°C at 2 am (7/17).

Temperature Log for Refrigerator (Fahrenheit) Month/Year ...

Refrigerators should maintain temperatures between 2°C and 8°C (36°F and 46°F). Freezers should maintain temperatures between -50°C and -15°C (-58°F and +5°F). Refrigerator or freezer thermostats should be set at the factory-set or midpoint temperature, which will decrease the likelihood of temperature excursions.

Every vaccine storage unit must have a temperature monitoring device, and investing in reliable devices is less expensive than replacing vaccines wasted due to inaccurate temperature readings. CDC recommends the use of a continuous monitoring and recording digital data logger (DDL) with a current and valid Certificate of Calibration Testing (also known as a Report of Calibration), set at a minimum recording interval of at least every 30 min.

Vaccine storage and handling

CDC clarified storage unit temperatures: Refrigerator temperature should measure between 2°C and 8°C (34°F and 46°F) Although vaccines can be correctly stored anywhere within the aforementioned temperature range, storage unit temperatures should still aim midpoint of 5°C to avoid temperature excursions.
