Unscrew an oil cooler line from the radiator using the line wrench. This will spill out some oil, so you may want to keep the drain pan handy. Follow the oil line to the oil filter, and unbolt the bracket that holds the oil lines to the engine using the 3/8-inch ratchet and socket.

Replacing the oil cooler involves removing the mounting hardware or fasteners, disconnecting the two lines from the oil cooler, and installing the new oil cooler in its place. Afterwards, the engine oil system will be flushed, drained and refilled with clean oil, and the oil filter will be changed as well.

Remove the engine oil cooler lines from the quick connectors at the radiator engine oil cooler inlet and outlet. Pull the lines straight out from the connectors. Remove engine oil cooler lines from the vehicle. Important: Have a drain pan ready for the engine oil to drain into.
