SB 562 analysis - California

This study by Robert Pollin, James Heintz, Peter Arno and Jeannette Wicks-Lim provides an economic analysis of the proposed measure, The Healthy California Act (SB-562). The study finds that the proposed single-payer system could provide decent health care for all California residents while still reducing net overall health care costs by about 8 percent relative to the existing system.
