Today's judgment is a disappointment for Margaret McTear, who sued Imperial Tobacco for £500,000 damages following the death of her husband Alfred McTear from lung cancer.

On the 31st May 2005, Judge Lord Nimmo Smith, in the Supreme Court of Scotland, gave his 'Opinion' in the Case 'Mrs Margaret McTear against Imperial Tobacco Company'. Mr McTear, supported by the Medical Establishment, had started an action for damages against Imperial Tobacco because he had been diagnosed with lung cancer. He claimed that smoking was the cause of the lung cancer, and that Imperial Tobacco were responsible.

[14] The test to be applied in this court is whether the Lord Ordinary exercised his discretion as no Lord Ordinary could reasonably have done (Stevenson v Midlothian District Council, supra; McTear v Imperial Tobacco Ltd, supra). It is the first such case in the United Kingdom to reach the stage of a full hearing. Margaret McTear, the widow of Alfred McTear, who died of lung cancer aged 48 in 1993, is suing Imperial Tobacco for £500 000 (\$830 000; €710 000). Mr McTear lodged the claim shortly before his death.
