The Common Application short answer asks you to briefly elaborate on your extracurricular activities or work experience. Specifically, briefly means using fewer than 1000 characters, or just more than 150 words. Your answer will be truncated if it exceeds this limit.

Short Answer Questions In lieu of an essay or personal statement, we ask interested applicants to answer a series of short answer questions. Answering the following questions is optional, but strongly encouraged for U.S. applicants and required for international applicants.

Short answer responses are the perfect opportunity for you to fill in any holes in the rest of your application. If you haven't been able to discuss something in your work history that could be seen as a weakness, figure out how you can explain it in a short answer.

MBA Application: How to Respond to Short Answer Questions ...

In lieu of an essay or personal statement, we ask applicants to complete short answer questions. The Admissions Committee reviews responses for quality rather than length. However, the most effective responses typically range from 200-300 words per question. Responses that are longer or shorter are acceptable.

Short Answer Questions | University of Pittsburgh

All applicants must submit three required short answers and may submit one optional short answer responding to prompts in your admissions application. Answers are limited to no more than 40 lines, or about 250-300 words, typically the length of one paragraph. Note Special Requirements for Spring 2020 Applicants: Social Work requires an additional short answer question of their applicants.
