The first step in developing a new Spanish placement test was determining what kind of new test was needed to ensure that students would be assigned at the appropriate level.

The grammar module of the Spanish Placement Test deals primarily with questions of syntax. Grammatical content of the texts used in the first and second year courses was analyzed noting the stage at which certain concepts were introduced and when such concepts were reviewed in the second year.

If Spanish was your high school language, you must take the online placement exam to determine the appropriate placement. AP, SATII, IB, and college transfer credits can be used to satisfy Gen Ed requirements, but should you wish to continue your study of Spanish, we recommend that you take the placement exam to ensure proper placement.

Reading placement is now a part of the English placement exam. If you have not taken a reading placement and wish to take an English placement, the reading component is automatically assigned to you. Results are printed at the end of the exam and a copy of the results is given to you when you are finished.
