Low Brain Blood Flow May Spur Alzheimer's Hallmark

Tangles form when tau is misfolded in a very specific way. In Alzheimer's disease, the tau forms a C-shape in the core of the tangle with a loose end sticking out randomly. In Pick's disease, the core forms a J-shape instead. Once a tangle has been started, more tau proteins are recruited to make it longer.
