Educational technology that all students might access as part of the normal course of literacy instruction should be distinguished from the subcategory referred to as assistive technology. Software and hardware that are purposefully identified for use by students with disabilities in order to complete academic and everyday tasks are considered assistive technology.

Responsibly Incorporating Technology Into Literacy ...

Differentiating traditional versus learning with technology revealed that, on average, 39% of literacy activities included use of technology. The median amount of time with technology within literacy instruction and activity was 33% and, interestingly, the mode was 0% of technology use during literacy teaching and learning.
