The Hebrew word for what Solomon asked for and received is shama, which is a "hearing" heart (see 1 Kings 3:9,11). He asked for a listening heart, one that could clearly hear the Lord's direction and guidance. Solomon wanted to go back to the way it was in the Garden of Eden.

If you look at the Hebrew language, Solomon really asked for a heart that was trained to listen. He prayed for the gift of a listening heart. If we are going to hear the voice of God, we must have a listening heart. So many are hard-of-hearing. So many more of us are hard-of-listening. Barriers often prevent us from listening.

The act of listening is obedience. We see this in Deuteronomy 28:1-2 "Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that the Lord your God will set you high above all nations of the earth.
