A theatrical performance includes a number of factors which the director combines to convey his overall vision or message to the spectator. One important function of a general theatrical theory or semiotics is to distinguish the various components of the scenic action or performance. Tadeusz Kowzan has defined thirteen such components, regarding each of them as a separate sign system.
