Requirements for work in the UK UK work visas. UK work-related visas are changing in light of the 2016 Brexit vote. From 1 January 2021, EU/EFTA citizens will be treated the same as third-country nationals and will need a visa to work in the UK. Currently there are only work visas available in the UK for skilled migrants and those working in shortage occupations. In 2020, the UK government announced the introduction of a new points-based system that will come into effect from the start of 2021.

The UK is particularly strict about work visas. You cannot just move to England, get a job, and then get that job to sponsor you for a visa. You must have sponsorship before you go. When you apply for a visa, you will be placed into one of five tiers, which measure your application against a set of criteria (source).

Your right to work in the UK depends on where you travel from as well as what type of work you want to do. You may well need a UK work visa as well as a job offer in order to take up employment. The UK is currently an EU member state. This means that citizens from other EU/EFTA states have the freedom to travel to and work in the UK.

A new immigration system will apply to people arriving in the UK from 1 January 2021 and EU citizens moving to the UK to work will need to get a visa in advance.

In respect to income tax, where a member of the household is working and earning in the UK then tax on those earnings will be payable in the UK. If the income earner is employed, including as a director of an owner-managed company, then UK income tax will be collected through the employer's PAYE scheme.

People who love to travel and work in Europe, may wish to secure work in England. The UK Home Office judges most work visas based on a points system of importance, skill and connection. You must be able to prove a good connection to employment in the UK and financial support if you are living with family.

If you've already found a job in the UK and been accepted to work, or you have a visa but it prohibits you from working, you may need to obtain a work permit. You cannot apply for a work permit directly. Your employer in the UK will need to apply on your behalf.

You are allowed to work in the UK if you are on a course with (i) a UK higher education institution or (ii) a publicly funded further education college. International students participating in a higher education course can work up to 20 hours per week during term time, which is a similar arrangement to other countries(e.g. Australian and NZ).

Moreover, in UK, similar to most of the top international study destinations, foreign students are allowed to work part-time. In the UK as an international student, you're allowed to work up to 20 hours at maximum per week during term-time and full-time during holiday breaks.

So you can continue to live and work in the UK. You will, however, need to take action. If you want to continue living in the UK after 31 December 2020, you must apply to the UK government for settled status by 30 June 2021 at the latest.
